She brought a range of historical objects that the children enjoyed investigating and discussing.

We also have strong links with other schools in the local area and were very pleased to welcome Mr Mark Smith from **Lawnswood School** on Wednesday to run his annual maths puzzles workshop with Year 5. This is always a fun event in the calendar and a chance for the children to start forming positive impressions about the teachers at secondary school and to assuage worries about transition.

Year 2 were great ambassadors for the school yesterday on their trip to **Whistlestop Valley**. They enjoyed learning about (and riding on) the steam train and the history of the area. They have great ideas to inform their further topic work now.

We have been gifted a very special, signed first edition of a graphic novel



for the library. Rory and Austin have been painstakingly working on Skull Dude for some time now and it has gone to press! They will be selling copies at the Thought Bubble convention coming up soon, but will be taking orders for any spare copies they have after that. Let them know if you are
