

Dear Parents and Carers

It has been lovely to see so many families of our younger children this morning at the first **Stay and Play** of the year. We hope these give you a chance to see and understand their classrooms and learning areas as well as give opportunities for informal conversations with the class staff.

This week it has also been good to share with you the sukkahs (special shelters) we have been building as we find out about the Jewish festival of **Sukkot**. Many of these were built outside as we get into good habits with our outdoor learning as the school year begins. School was very quiet on the occasions when nearly every single class was outside!

This week children in Y1, Y2 and Y4 have had the opportunity to take part in **mini athletics** sessions, which looked very enjoyable. It is helpful if children keep their PE kits in school so that they can always take part in opportunities like this. Other than older children who may be entering puberty, most PE kits can tolerate a half term's use before going home for a wash (as that is the equivalent of about two full days wear). With PE kits it is helpful if children with longer hair keep a few hair elastics so they can tie it up for safety before PE and games.

This week we had a special assembly on **democracy at school** and thought about all the ways we try to listen to pupils' voices here at Shire Oak. We introduced our **House Team Captains** who are all the children in Year 6. They then led their first house team meetings on Wednesday morning for KS1 and KS2. We reminded all the classes to vote for their **Class Councillors** for **School Council** and encouraged Year 5 to consider standing for election as vice-chairs so that they can then be the chairs in Year 6. This year we are very proud to have a candidate in the **Leeds Children's Mayor** elections! Atticus (Year 6) was successful in his nomination and is now standing for election with a campaign about poverty. All children in Leeds have two votes (so they can vote for a candidate from their school and one other). We have tried to make sure all children at Shire Oak have had a chance to vote this week, but if your child missed it or you know other children who might not have voted, please encourage them to get involved. Please do encourage a good turn out from the young people connected to our school!
