

Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back to a new school year at Shire Oak and a very warm welcome to our new families joining us this September.

It has been lovely to hear about the children's adventures this summer holiday as well as their excitement for their new classes. The new Reception Class are lovely and are settling in so well! I have been very impressed with how they are tackling all the new changes and showing some lovely cooperation and learning skills as they explore the classroom and outside area.

To help keep **children safe** at home and at school, we regularly include information about Internet safety. To help with promoting those messages at home we share a monthly newsletter that helps parents keep on top of the changing world of technology and Internet enabled devices. September's edition is attached. On the subject of safety, we have upgraded the entry and exit



systems on our gates this summer and added additional maglocks to certain doors around school. (We have also had the roof on Reception and Pre School repaired.) Y5 and Y6 are pleased to have lockers again as there were previously just hooks in the Upper KS2 cloakrooms. (It is worth making sure that children's bags fit comfortably in their lockers along with their coats. We do still have some hooks for very wet coats, etc. though.)

This week we have included information from Wheatfields Hospice and SENDIASS (the Leeds organisation for supporting parents and carers with advice and support if their children have special educational needs and/or a disability.)

This week's letter is short as the focus has been on **settling in and building new relationships** so there aren't trips to report on or many photos to share. That doesn't mean nothing exciting has happened this week, however, and I have spied every class enjoying their learning whether outdoors showing hundreds, tens and ones with fallen fruit or constructing with the Scrap Shed materials or in their classrooms enjoying crisp new exercise books and the autumn term topics and class novels. I look forward to sharing glimpses of school life in the weeks to come.
