#### Welcome to Aruvi Aru class!

We hope that you and your child had an enjoyable Summer holiday and we would like to welcome you all back to the new school year.

# **Topic**

Our general topic this term is the history, geography and science led 'Going on a Journey' (including learning about the history of transport, about working with maps and about materials and their uses) and you will receive details soon of this half-term's homework. This will consist of a topic task, some maths activities, spelling and reading.

# **English**

Across the term, we will be reading a variety of class books together for pleasure and to inspire our writing. The first class book will be "Journey" by Aaron Becker. Children will have daily spelling lessons alongside guided reading lessons. In addition, each child will be given a **reading book** and reading record, which should be **sent into school every day**. We will listen to them read in school at least once a week and recommend that they read at home with an adult **3-4 times a week for 10 minutes.** Please write in your child's reading record when they have read at home. We will visit the school library on Thursdays where every child will have the opportunity to choose a book, which they can also take home.

### Maths

In maths this term we will be learning about place value, addition and subtraction within 100 and shape. The times tables that children will be learning this year are 10, 2 and 5 times tables. They will learn to mentally recall all multiplication and division facts for these times tables.

### P.E.

Our P.E. days this term are **Wednesday** and **Friday**. Children should bring P.E. kit consisting of: black/dark shorts/tracksuit bottoms, a white or purple t-shirt and trainers/pumps. This should be in a bag which is left in school for the half term.

Please note that Year 2 swimming does not start until after the Easter holidays.

For the majority of the week I will teach the class with **Miss Corner** and **Mrs Atwal** supporting the children. When I am out of class preparing lessons and assessing progress the class will be taught by **Ms Virgin** (art) and by **Mrs Mitchell**.

Finally, please get in touch with me either directly in the playground or through the school office if you have any worries, concerns or questions about your child's progress. It is important that we work together to ensure your child is happy at school and meeting their learning potential.
